SHHH... Give me a "K"

I am proud to say that I am the bane of Italian restaurants when it comes to their menu misspellings and mispronunciations of Italian words.

It is my belief that, if they choose to use the genuine Italian language, they better get it right or they'll feel my wrath and scorn.

There is one particular word which, when mispronounced by those who should know better, infuriates me to incendiary levels.
